**Subject: Grant in aid under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Multi sectoral Development Programme for Minority Concentration Districts to Government of West Bengal for the year 2011-12 for Birbhum District.**

Sir,

In continuation to this Ministry's sanction letter of even number dated 28.2.11 I am directed to convey the sanction of the President for release of an amount of Rs. **3, 07, 17,000/- (Rupees three crore seven lakh and seventeen thousand only)** as 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment for the year 2011-12 to the Govt. of West Bengal for implementing the scheme "Multi Sectoral Development Programme for minority concentration district" for Birbhum district as per the details enclosed at Annexure -I. The non-recurring grant may be released to the Govt. of West Bengal through CAS, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur.

2. The State Government should ensure that proportionate State share should be released by the State Govt. to the implementing agency alongwith Central share for the projects mentioned at **Annexure -I**.
3. The expenditure is debitable to Demand No.67, Ministry of Minority Affairs Major Head- "3601" Grant-in-aid to State Government, 04- Grants for Centrally sponsored Plan Schemes (Sub Major Head), 378 - General-(Welfare of Schedule Casts/Schedule Tribes and Other Backward Classes) -Other Grants, 04 - Multi sectoral Development Programme for minorities, 04.00.35 - Grant for creation of capital assets for the year 2011-12.
4. A copy of the Utilization certificate of 1<sup>st</sup> instalment is enclosed.
5. The sanction is issued on the commitment given by the State Govt. that villages/locations having a substantial minority population will be selected for the projects mentioned at Annexure -I and also that duplication will not take place.
6. Utilization Certificate for this grant should be submitted by the grantee in the prescribed format within 12 months of the closure of financial year. As per the conditions contained in para 15.4 of the guideline of Multi sectoral Development Programme, (i) Quarterly Progress Report, (ii) Photographs of the works completed from earlier releases and (iii) work plan for the requisitioned amount may also be furnished.
7. The State Government should ensure that a board containing information of the date of sanction of the project, likely date of completion, estimated cost of the project, source of funding i.e. MsDP (Government of India), contractor(s) name and the physical target is displayed. After completion of projects, a permanent display would be installed.
8. Funds should be released by the State Govt. to the implementing agencies immediately upon receipt of the same from Govt. of India and as per the directions of Govt. of India, Ministry of Finance; parking of funds at any level is strictly prohibited.
