Subject: Grant in aid under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Multi sectoral Development Programme for minorities to Government of **Assam for Hailakandi District**.

Sir.

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President for release of an amount of Rs.1,19,68,500/- (Rupees one crore nineteen lakh sixty eight thousand and five hundred only) as remaining part of the 1<sup>st</sup> installment of Rs. 239.37 lakh to the Govt. of Assam for implementing the scheme "Multi Sectoral Development Programme for Minority Concentration Blocks (MCBs) in Hailakandi district as per the details enclosed at Annexure I. Earliar Rs. 119.685 lakh has already been released as part of the 1<sup>st</sup> instalment vide sanction of even no. dated 26.03.2014. The non-recurring grant may be released to the Govt. of Assam through CAS, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur.

- 2. The expenditure is debitable to Demand No.68, Ministry of Minority Affairs Major Head- "3601" Grant-in-aid to State Governments, 02- Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes (Sub Major Head), 378 -General-(Welfare of Schedule Casts, Schedule Tribes, Other Backward Classes and Minorities) -Other Grants (Minority Head), 01 Multi sectoral Development Programme for minorities in selected minority concentration districts, 01.00.35 Grant for creation of capital assets for the year 2014-15.
- 3. Since it is a fresh release for the plan of MsDP, no UC is pending. Utilization Certificate for this grant should be submitted by the grantee in the prescribed format within 12 months of the closure of financial year. As per the conditions contained in para 8.4 of the guideline of Restructured Multi sectoral Development Programme, (i) Quarterly Progress Report, (ii) Utilization Certificate and (iii) Report regarding release of the state share in case of innovative projects may also be furnished.
- 4. The State Government should ensure that a board containing information as per Template enclosed at Annexure-III is displayed at the site. After completion of projects, a permanent display would be installed.

- 5. The sanction is issued on the commitment given by the State Govt. that villages/locations having a substantial minority population will be selected for the projects and also that duplication will not take place.
- 6. Funds should be released by the State Govt. to the implementing agencies immediately upon receipt of the same from Govt. of India and as per the directions of Govt. of India, Ministry of Finance; parking of funds at any level is strictly prohibited.
- 7. Utilisation of the above mentioned amount by the State Government is subject to the terms and conditioned at **Annexure-II.**
- 8. This sanction issues with concurrence of IFD vide their Dy. No. 119/IFD dated 22.05.2014. It is noted at S. No. ..... in the Grant-in-aid Register.
